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### **Registration**

Everyone attending the conference is required to complete an official registration form, available from our website [www.cnfnepal.org](http://www.cnfnepal.org) or can be obtained on request from [cnfn@himaltech.com](mailto:cnfn@himaltech.com). As space is limited, participants are strongly encouraged to pre-register for the conference as soon as possible.

Registration for the conference opens 10 December 2006. Registration closes on 28 February 2007. Re-confirmation of participation could be done till 9 March 2007..

All participants other than the accompanying adopted Nepalese child must pay the registration fee confirmed and fixed by the Conference Main Organizing Committee. Accompanying adopted Nepalese Child (one) are provided with full scholarship.

Registration fee provides for a conference program, entrance to all plenary, symposia, and concurrent sessions, including workshop, daily coffee/snack breaks, and all conference meals.

### **Conference Hotel**

The conference sessions will be at the Hotel Soaltee Crowne Plaza, one of the most exquisite and centrally located 5 star hotels in Nepal.

**Lodging**

Hotel Soaltee Crowne Plaza and Hotel De l" Annapurna the two official hotels of the International Conference. All conference activities will take place at Hotel Soaltee Crowne Plaza, but participants may organize for their accommodations at in either hotels or in other hotels according to their preferences. ## **Visas**

Entrance visas are obtainable at the Kathmandu airport for those arriving by airplane. There is a counter to purchase the visas in the immigration area. The visa fee is USD .... . ## **Tours**

Excursions will be arranged to historic and scenic areas in Kathmandu and nearby places. on 11 March, as a part of the conference, participants will be taken to Kathmandu valley tour followed by a dinner at the courtyard of one of the three historic cities of Kathmandu valley accompanied by a traditional, but enchanting cultural program. For the participants willing to stay longer and visit places like Pokhara, Chitwan, and other places, the conference secretarial will make necessary bookings and arrangements upon the request of the participants. For any extra activities other than mentioned in the conference program schedule, the participants will have to pay extra as per the price quoted.

## **Currency**

The official currency in Nepal is the Nepalese Rupees, which are found in 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 25, 50, 100, 500 and 1000 denominations. Besides paper notes, 1 and 2 rupees are widely available in metal (brass) coin. Foreign currencies may be exchanged for Nepalese Rupees at airport bank, other banks in the city, in hotels or in exchange counters. The exchange mate may vary according to the rate set by country's Central Bank. All banks post the daily exchange rate on their boards.

Many credit cards are accepted at the leading hotels, travel agents, airlines offices, restaurants departmental stores and other major business places.

## **Internet & Business Center**

The conference official hotel provides "internet café" with a limited number of Internet stations for hotel guests. In addition, the hotel has a business center in which many services are available. Internet service and other business services are available on payment of the charges according to the rates fixed by the hotel. The conference registration fee or with or without package does not include these services. Participant using these services have to pay the applicable charges by themselves before checking out from the hotel.
